Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's reappointment of Matthew P. Brockelman as a member of the Downtown Development Review Board (DDRB), as a downtown business owner representative, for a first full term ending June 30, 2023.

Background Information: The DDRB is established pursuant to Section 656.361.9, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to review and make decisions with respect to all applications for development and redevelopment within the Downtown Overlay Zone. The nine voting members of the board are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, in various categories including downtown property owners or owners of or full time employees at a downtown business or professional office.

Mr. Brockelman has worked at The Southern Group since 2014. Mr. Brockelman has a Bachelor of Business Administration in corporate finance and marketing from the University of North Florida. He resides in Council District #7.
