Type of Action: Appropriation and CIP amendment

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$1,250,000 (\$1,100,000 from the Traffic Signalization - Countywide Project and \$150,000 from the Countywide Intersection Imp - Intersection Project) to the Traffic Signal (New) New Berlin Road and Cedar Point Road Project. The 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan is amended to transfer funding for the project.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the installation of a new traffic signal at the intersection of New Berlin Road and Cedar Point Road and realignment of the intersection for safer geometry. The project will also complete roadwork and drainage improvements. Traffic studies of this intersection indicate that a new signal will improve operations, improve commuter drive times and reduce congestion.

Policy Impact Area: Traffic signal - New Berlin Road and Cedar Point Road

Fiscal Impact: \$1,250,000 as initiated by B.T. 23-040, this is a transfer of funds with no new costs to the City

Analyst: Hampsey
