AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THAT CERTAIN SOVEREIGNTY SUBMERGED LANDS LEASE (BOT NO. 160359172) BETWEEN THE CITY JACKSONVILLE, JACKSONVILLE UNIVERSITY, AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA "LEASE"), FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING SUBMERGED LAND FOR CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A FOUR-SLIP (10,065 SQUARE FOOT) COMMERCIAL DOCKING FACILITY ON THE ST. JOHNS RIVER IN THE MAYPORT COMMUNITY FOR MOORING OF COMMERCIAL VESSELS AND TO SUPPORT THE JACKSONVILLE UNIVERSITY OCEARCH VESSEL, FOR A TEN YEAR INITIAL TERM COMMENCING SEPTEMBER 21, 2021, WITH AN INITIAL ANNUAL LEASE FEE OF \$4,960.10, PLUS A 25% SURCHARGE AND SALES TAX, SUBJECT TO ANNUAL ADJUSTMENTS TO THE LEASE FEE THEREAFTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH 18-21.011, FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE; PROVIDING OF ACQUISITION, OVERSIGHT EXECUTION AND RECORDING OF THE LEASE BY THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, AND OVERSIGHT OF THE LEASE AND DOCKING FACILITY BY THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Sovereignty Submerged Lands Lease Approved.

There is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, that certain Sovereignty Submerged Lands Lease (BOT File No. 160359172) (the "Lease") between the City of Jacksonville and Jacksonville University (collectively, the "Lessee") and the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida (the "Lessor"), in substantially the same form as has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services. The Lease provides that the Lessee shall pay an initial annual lease fee of \$4,960.10 and a 25% surcharge plus sales tax. The annual lease fee for the remaining years of the Lease will be adjusted pursuant to the provisions of 18-21.011, Florida Administrative Code.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the Lease is to secure submerged land for the construction and operation of a four-slip (10,065 square foot) commercial docking facility on the St. Johns River in the Mayport community as depicted in Revised Exhibit 1, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised Maps, April 18, 2022 - NCSPHS", attached hereto. The docking facility will be used for mooring of commercial vessels and to support the OCEARCH vessel at Jacksonville University, commercial fishermen, and local charter fishing and recreational vessels. The initial term of the Lease is ten years commencing on September 21, 2021 and is renewable at the sole option of the Lessor.

Section 3. Oversight. The Real Estate Division of the Department of Public Works shall provide initial oversight of the acquisition, execution and recording of the Lease. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department shall thereafter provide
