Type of Action: Use Agreement

Bill Summary: This legislation authorizes the Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Jacksonville Offshore Sports Fishing Club Inc. for the use of William “Bill” Gulliford, Jr. Community Center.

Background Information: The William “Bill” Gulliford, Jr. Community Center is located at 4875 Ocean Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32233 The agreement is for a three-year term at the cost of \$1.00 per year. The Agreement provides that the Club will use the Facility for various Club activities including meetings, tournaments, and other events.

Club meetings at the Facility will occur twice a month and will be open to the public. The Club intends to use these meetings as an opportunity provide information on a variety of relevant topics including, for example, information on sports fishing, artificial and natural reefs, safe boating, and marine and natural resources conservation, as well as hands-on instruction on bait rigging, cast net throwing, trailer backing, and boat maintenance.

Oversight will be done by the Parks Department.
