

# **Business Impact Estimate**

Proposed ordinance's title/reference:

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A PRELIMINARY RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE RATE ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 715, ORDINANCE CODE; STATING THE GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR SERVICE COST; PROVIDING FOR ASSESSMENT RATE; REPEALING MAXIMUM ASSESSMENT RATE; SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE ANNUAL RATE ORDINANCE; DIRECTING PREPARATION OF THE ASSESSMENT ROLL, PUBLICATION OF NOTICE, AND MAILING OF NOTICES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

1. Summary of the proposed ordinance (must include a statement of the public purpose, such as serving the public health, safety, morals, and welfare)

This proposed ordinance is the first of two ordinances as part of the process of increasing the solid waste assessment on residential properties from \$12.65 per month to \$30.40 per month and eliminates the previously adopted maximum rate of \$18 per month. The public purpose is to fund the solid waste service.

2. An estimate of the direct economic impact of the proposed ordinance on private, for-profit businesses in the City of Jacksonville, if any:

- (a) An estimate of direct compliance costs that businesses may reasonably incur;
- (b) Any new charge or fee imposed by the proposed ordinance or for which businesses will be financially responsible; and
- (c) An estimate of the City of Jacksonville's regulatory costs, including estimated revenues from any new charges or fees to cover such costs.

This bill does not impose any new charge or fee and does not impose any new compliance costs on businesses. This ordinance will increase the solid waste assessment and eliminate the maximum rate on residential properties.
