Presentation on JU Women's Health Innovation Hub

Dr. Joshi, Chief Health Officer Mayor's Office, gave a presentation about the proposed JU Women's Health Innovation Hub. He spoke about poor health outcomes for women in Duval County, cancer and STD diagnosis, infant mortality rates and prenatal care.

Dr. Christine Sapienza, Jacksonville University Executive Vice President Office of Partnerships & Development, described the vision for the Hub and the collaboration with the Mayo Clinic on an NSF grant. She referenced a dollar to dollar match from Delores Barr Weaver.

Council Member Amaro indicated his plan to restore the full funding (\$250,000) for this project. Council Member Boylan asked about job creation and the specific purpose for the funds for the project. Council Member Salem said 2024-0460, which includes the appropriation for the JU Women's Health Innovation Hub, will be taken up by the Finance Committee at the September 4th meeting.

Mr. Randolph said that the locations of pickup and destination are tracked. She emphasized that this program should be a supplement to not a replacement for neighborhood grocery stores.
