The Navy has offered to contribute the remaining 50% of the appraised value up to a certain maximum. If this grant application is successful, the requested Ordinance would authorize the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary to execute the and deliver all grant agreements and associated documents, including extensions.

Following acquisition, the grant reimbursement is to be returned to the project account to be used for park development within three years which is a requirement of the grant program.
