Bill Summary: This bill closes and abandons and/or disclaims an unopened and unimproved portion of right-of-

way of the Moat Street Alley in District 10.

Background Information: The Applicant owns property adjacent to the closure area at 0 Moat Street and is requesting the closure of the property, with plans for the potential development of a multi-tenant garage or warehouse. The Applicant paid the right-of-way closure application fee of \$2,091.00, and the closure request was reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the right-ofway with no objections. The closure and disclaiming of the property is contingent upon a Hold Harmless Covenant, which protects the City from legal liability of any potential injury resulting from use of the disclaimed property, between the Applicant and the City.
