5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$153,000.00 FROM
6 THE SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (THE
7 "FUND") FOR DONATIONS TO BIG BROTHERS BIG
8 SISTERS OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC.
9 (\$15,000.00), DOWNTOWN VISION ALLIANCE, INC.
10 (\$10,000.00), FLORIDA SHERIFFS YOUTH RANCHES,
11 INC. (\$20,000.00), OPERATION SAVE OUR SONS,
12 INC. (\$40,000.00), AND THE ORANGE COUNTY
13 SHERIFF'S OFFICE, NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON
14 PREVENTING CRIME IN THE BLACK COMMUNITY
15 (\$3,000.00) IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION
16 932.7055(5), FLORIDA STATUTES, TO SUPPORT
17 SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER, CRIME PREVENTION,
18 SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD, AND DRUG ABUSE EDUCATION
19 AND PREVENTION PROGRAMS, APPROPRIATING
20 \$65,000.00 FROM THE FUND TO REIMBURSE THE
21 GENERAL FUND FOR FORFEITURE-RELATED
22 EXPENDITURES IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION
23 932.7055(4)(C), FLORIDA STATUTES, AND
24 REALLOCATING A TOTAL OF \$82,610.40 IN PRIOR
25 YEAR RESIDUAL BALANCES, AS INITIATED BY B.T.
26 21-063; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; APPROVING
27 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE,
28 AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND
29 DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE
30 MISCELLANEOUS APPROPRIATIONS AGREEMENT BETWEEN
31 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND BIG BROTHERS BIG

10 INC.; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE
11 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN
12 EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
16 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the
17 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
18 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

19 (B.T. 21-063 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein
20 by this reference)

25 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

26 The funding above represents an appropriation of
27 \$88,000.00 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund
28 for donations to various organizations as set forth
29 herein to support school resource officer, crime
30 prevention, safe neighborhood, and drug abuse education
31 and prevention programs administered by various agencies.

1 In addition, the funding above represents an
2 appropriation of \$65,000.00 from the Fund to reimburse
3 the General Fund for forfeiture-related expenditures, and
4 a reallocation of \$82,610.40 in prior year residual
5 balances.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
7 Section 1 is to provide donations to the following organizations,
8 in the stated amounts: Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northeast
9 Florida, Inc. (\$15,000.00), Downtown Vision Alliance, Inc.
10 (\$10,000.00), Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc. (\$20,000.00),
11 Operation Save Our Sons, Inc. (\$40,000.00), and Orange County
12 Sheriff's Office, National Conference on Preventing Crime in the
13 Black Community (\$3,000.00). This allocation supports school
14 resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, and drug
15 abuse education and prevention program services to the citizens of
16 the City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida. A Certification
17 from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office that the subject
18 appropriation from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund complies
19 with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, is attached hereto as
20 **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

21 In addition to the above, this appropriation includes a
22 transfer of \$65,000.00 from the Fund to the General Fund as a
23 reimbursement for forfeiture-related expenditures in accordance
24 with Section 932.7055(4)(c), Florida Statutes, and a realloaction
25 of \$82,610.40 in residual balances from prior year appropriations.

26 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby
27 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
28 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
29 the City, the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the
30 City of Jacksonville and Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northeast
31 Florida, Inc., the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between

1 the City of Jacksonville and Downtown Vision Alliance, Inc., the
2 Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City of
3 Jacksonville and the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc., and the
4 Miscelllaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City of
5 Jacksonville and Operation Save Our Sons, Inc., in substantially
6 the same forms as have been placed **On File** with the Office of
7 Legislative Services.

8 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
9 shall oversee the projects described herein.

10 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
11 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
12 without the Mayor's signature.
