ORDINANCE 2023-762-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$140,000, INCLUDING \$70,000 FROM THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S DESIGNATED CONTINGENCY AND \$70,000 FROM THE MAYOR'S TASK FORCE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO THE WOMEN'S CENTER OF JACKSONVILLE, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF SEXUAL ASSAULT FORENSIC MEDICAL EXAMS AND RELATED SERVICES; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AN ELEVENTH AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE WOMEN'S CENTER TO INCREASE CITY'S MAXIMUM INDEBTEDNESS UNDER THE AGREEMENT BY AN ADDITIONAL \$140,000 FOR A NEW TOTAL MAXIMUM INDEBTEDNESS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$1,863,419; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT, SOCIAL SERVICES DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, Section 1. within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation - The funding above represents an appropriation of \$140,000, including \$70,000 from the Council President's Designated Contingency and \$70,000 from the Mayor's Task Force Contingency account, to provide funding to the Women's Center of Jacksonville, Inc. (the "Women's Center"). These funds must be expended by September 30, 2024.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 above is to provide additional funding to the Women's Center for sexual assault exams and related services for victims of sexual assault. The Women's Center has requested this additional funding to offset a portion of the reduction in funding they expected to receive from the State of Florida, Office of the Attorney General Victims of Crime Act funds. These funds will assist the Women's Center in ensuring 24-hour coverage and response for sexual assault survivors, to include costs associated with the S.A.F.E. Center and staff availability 24 hours a day.

Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Execute Amendment.

There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute an Eleventh Amendment to the Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Women's Center of Jacksonville, Inc. (the "MOA"), in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference, to increase the maximum indebtedness under the MOA by an additional \$140,000 for a new total maximum indebtedness not-to-exceed \$1,863,419.

Section 4. Oversight. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department, Social Services Division, shall have oversight of the project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
