Florida Mechanical Systems, Inc. proposes to construct a corporate headquarters and administrative building for lease to W. W. Gay Mechanical Contractor, Inc. The 49,200 square foot office building is being constructed to replace the previous headquarters building destroyed by fire in August 2020. The project site is located within a Level 2 Distressed Area. The cost of the project is \$15.3 million. Retaining the corporate headquarters of W. W. Gay within the Urban Core retains approximately 600 full time jobs and creates 60 new full-time jobs within five years after construction is completed. The average wage of the jobs to be created is \$83,700 plus benefits, adding \$5 million in annual payroll.

The Company has indicated that the financial incentives proposed are a material factor in the corporate headquarters remaining in the Urban Core versus selecting a greenfield site for the project.

The support the project the city is proposing to offer 10-year 50% REV Grant, based on the proposed \$15.3 million investment and the addition 60 new full-time equivalent jobs, by the end of 2028. The average wage of the jobs is \$83,700. The REV Grant would be capped at \$700,000. Additionally, a Large-Scale Economic Development Fund Grant in the amount of \$500,000 is recommended to offset a portion of the site development expenses associated with the project. The total amount of City incentives would be up to \$1,200,000.

The funding request for the Large-Scale Economic Development Fund Grant is scheduled to be presented to the Northwest Economic Development Fund Advisory Board at their March 22, 2022, meeting.
