5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,527,240 FROM THE
6 GENERAL FUND TO THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S
7 OFFICE FOR ADMINISTRATION OF THE MISDEMEANOR
8 PROBATION PROGRAM FOR DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS
9 INITIATED BY B.T. 22-010; PURPOSE OF
10 APPROPRIATION; AUTHORIZING POSITIONS, AS
11 INITIATED BY R.C. 22-014; AMENDING CHAPTER 37
12 (OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION),
13 SECTION 37.111 (SCHEDULE OF FEES), *ORDINANCE*
14 *CODE*, TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR THE MISDEMEANOR
15 PROBATION PROGRAM; AMENDING JACKSONVILLE
16 SHERIFF'S OFFICE FEES AT

22 UPDATE OF FEES ONLINE; PROVIDING FOR
23 CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING FOR
24 OVERSIGHT OF THE PROGRAM BY THE JACKSONVILLE
25 SHERIFF'S OFFICE; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY
26 PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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28 **WHEREAS**, the Misdemeanor Probation Program (the "Program") for
29 Duval County, Florida is currently operated by a local branch of The
30 Salvation Army, a Georgia not-for-profit corporation; and

31 **WHEREAS**, Section 948.15, Florida Statutes, provides that a

1 private or public entity under the supervision of the governing body
2 of the county or the court may provide probation services for
3 offenders sentenced by the county court; and

4 **WHEREAS**, The Salvation Army's contract for the provision of
5 misdemeanor probation services for Duval County, Florida expires on
6 November 30, 2021, and the City of Jacksonville has designated the
7 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office ("JSO") to assume responsibility for
8 administration of the Program; and

9 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to an Administrative Order from the Chief
10 Judge of the Fourth Judicial Circuit, JSO will assume responsibility
11 for administration of the Program effective December 1, 2021; and

12 **WHEREAS**, funds for this Program will be paid by individuals
13 sentenced to misdemeanor probation through the Duval County court
14 system; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office is requesting the
16 City Council approve this legislation to appropriate funds to pay the
17 costs for the first year of the Program and to establish the various
18 fees to be collected from misdemeanor probationers to pay for
19 administration of the Program moving forward; now therefore

20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are true
22 and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

23 **Section 2. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
25 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
26 listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation from the General Fund to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office for administration of the Misdemeanor Probation Program for Duval County, Florida for the first year of the Program beginning December 1, 2021.

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation above is to provide funding for JSO to assume responsibility for the Program effective December 1, 2021. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Department of Corrections will provide client-centric misdemeanor probation services for all of Duval County, Florida. These services will focus on criminogenic needs, risk to reoffend needs, and court ordered probation requirements.

Section 4. Authorization of Positions. There are hereby authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 22-014, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 5. Chapter 37 (Office of the Sheriff), Part 1 (Organization), Section 37.111 (Schedule of fees), Ordinance Code, amended. Chapter 37 (Office of the Sheriff), Part 1 (Organization), Section 37.111 (Schedule of fees), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 **Section 6. Amending Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Fees.**

18 The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office fees which were directed by
19 Ordinance 2017-665-E to be published at
20 <http://www.jaxsheriff.org/fees> are hereby amended to reflect new fees
21 for the Misdemeanor Probation Program and the provision of supervision
22 and probation services, as reflected in **Exhibit 3** attached hereto and
23 incorporated herein by this reference.
