Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$36,000, a transfer of funds from General Fund – GSD debt service interest savings to the Board of Library Trustees Trust Fund for administration of the Story Journeys Summer Learning Program. The nature of the one cycle emergency is that these funds must be transferred prior to the end of fiscal year 2020-2021.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the Story Journeys Summer Learning Program. This is an annual Summer Reading program to encourage reading and learning all summer long. From June 1 to July 30, interested parties may participate in limited in-branch programs, interactive virtual events, and earn prizes. All of the programs are free and open to everyone.
