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## ORDINANCE 2024-603-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$90,750 FROM THE SOLID WASTE FACILITIES MITIGATION FUND RETAINED EARNINGS ACCOUNT TO THE EQUESTRIAN CENTER-NFES HORSE FUND WITHIN THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO THE NORTHEAST FLORIDA EQUESTRIAN SOCIETY/H.O.R.S.E. THERAPIES, INC. FOR OPERATIONAL EXPENSES IN FISCAL YEAR 2024; PROVIDING FOR REVERTER OF FUNDS; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A TENTH AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDED AND RESTATED EQUESTRIAN CENTER SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND NORTHEAST FLORIDA EQUESTRIAN SOCIETY/H.O.R.S.E. THERAPIES, INC., TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$90,750 from the Solid Waste Facilities Mitigation Fund Retained Earnings account to the Equestrian Center-NFES Horse Fund within the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department to Northeast Florida provide funds to the Equestrian Society/H.O.R.S.E. Therapies, Inc. ("NFES") for unanticipated increased operational expenses. This appropriation is intended to address a projected shortfall in funding for operational expenses for NFES in fiscal year 2024.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide additional funds to NFES for operational expenses in fiscal year 2024. The need for this appropriation arose when NFES identified that it would have a shortfall in funds to support its ongoing operational expenses due to a number of factors including increased insurance costs, cancellation of planned events, and other unanticipated operational overruns. NFES attempted to book three additional events in an effort to offset some of the revenue lost from the two that were cancelled, but none of those came to fruition. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department will make additional funds available from this appropriation for the monthly contractual payment by the City to NFES for the months of June, July, August and September in the exact amount needed to offset the increased operational expenses for each month.

Section 3. Reverter. Any funds from this appropriation

remaining on September 30, 2024, shall revert to the fund of origin.

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Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute Tenth Amendment to Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, a Tenth Amendment (the "Amendment") to the Amended and Restated Equestrian Center Services Contract Between the Jacksonville and Northeast Florida City of Equestrian Society/H.O.R.S.E. Therapies, Inc. (the "Agreement") to increase the maximum indebtedness by \$90,750 for a new total maximum indebtedness not-to-exceed \$5,522,685.93, subject to the payment terms outlined in this Ordinance. The Amendment may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or her designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Amendment by the Mayor, or her designee; provided however, no modifications may increase the financial obligations of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated herein or decrease the duties and obligations of NFES, and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel and the Office of Risk Management for insurance and indemnification terms. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City, and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Section 5. Oversight Department. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department shall have oversight of the project described herein.

Section 6. Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction

Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon

introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the Northeast Florida Equestrian Society has several important and immediate operational expenditures and obligations it must fulfill and these additional funds will ensure they can meet those obligations in a timely manner.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
