The funding above represents an appropriation of \$9,450,315.09 from nine (9) named projects to fund the construction of new Fire Station #78 and related improvements.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 11 12 Section 1 is to transfer funds from nine (9) named projects to fund the construction of new Fire Station #78 and related improvements 13 (the "Project"), as follows: (1) Fire Station #10 Renovation Project 14 15 (\$171,841.73), (2) Fire Station #64 (New) Project (\$1,014,487.74), (3) Fire Station #22 - New Construction Project (\$1,986,787.68), (4) 16 Fire Station #63 New Construction Project (\$263,169.30), (5) Fire 17 Station #47 Replace Project (\$3,260,740.70), (6) Fire Station #75 18 (New) Project (\$1,188,393.89), (7) Fire Station #17 Replacement 19 20 Project (\$79,220.02), (8) Fire Station #12 Replacement Project 21 (\$485,674.03), and (9) Fire Station #66 (New) Project (\$1,000,000). 22 The area in which the Project is located has a consistently high call 23 volume and the construction of Fire Station #78 will reduce response 24 times and call burden on surrounding fire districts.

25 Section 3. CIP Amendment. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year 26 27 Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its 2.8 independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the appropriation 29 of funds to the Projects, as more fully described in the Project 30 Information Sheets attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral 31

of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay the construction and completion of the Project.

5 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of 6 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the 7 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP 8 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute 9 an amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the 10 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2024-505-E 11 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
