## ORDINANCE 2026-4

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NEW SECTION 111.106  
(PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES  
EVENTS SPECIAL REVENUE FUND), PART 1 (PARKS,  
RECREATION, CULTURE AND ENTERTAINMENT),  
CHAPTER 111 (SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST  
ACCOUNTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO CREATE A NEW  
SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO DEFRAY COSTS OF EVENTS  
SPONSORED OR CO-SPONSORED BY THE PARKS,  
RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT;  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Creating Section 111.106 (Parks, Recreation and Community Services Events Special Revenue Fund), Part 1 (Parks, Recreation, Culture and Entertainment), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts), *Ordinance Code*. A new Section 111.106 (Parks, Recreation and Community Services Events Special Revenue Fund), Part 1 (Parks, Recreation, Culture and Entertainment), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby created to read as follows:

## CHAPTER 111. SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS.

## PART 1. PARKS, RECREATION, CULTURE AND ENTERTAINMENT.

Sec. 111.106. - Parks, Recreation and Community Services  
Events Special Revenue Fund.

There is hereby created the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Events Special Revenue Fund (the "Fund"), a permanent

1 special revenue fund of the City, into which shall be deposited all  
2 contributions, donations, monetary gifts, sponsorship monies and  
3 fees, and other forms of revenue as may be from time to time  
4 received by the City, which are charged or given to the City from  
5 nongovernmental sources, in connection with events, functions and  
6 activities sponsored or co-sponsored by the Parks, Recreation and  
7 Community Services Department. The Fund shall be used for the  
8 purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of such events,  
9 activities and functions. The foregoing revenues shall be deposited  
10 and maintained in separate sub activities within the Fund clearly  
11 identified by each Division of the Parks, Recreation and Community  
12 Services Department and the Office of Director, to give each  
13 Division of the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department  
14 and the Director of the Parks, Recreation and Community  
15 Services Department (the "Director") the ability to defray the cost  
16 and expenses of their respective events, activities and functions.  
17 The sums placed into the Fund, together with any interest accrued  
18 thereon, are hereby appropriated for purposes described in this  
19 Section, and such appropriations shall not lapse at the close of  
20 any fiscal year but shall carry over to the next fiscal year. The  
21 Director of the Finance Department is authorized and directed to  
22 make disbursements from the Fund upon the written request of the  
23 Director or his designee, subject to availability of funds from the  
24 Fund. Each Division shall submit a semi-annual report to the  
25 Director regarding the receipts and disbursements within such  
26 Division's sub activity within the Fund, and no later than June 30  
27 annually, the Director shall provide a report of all Fund receipts  
28 and disbursements to the City Council.
