ORDINANCE 2026-98

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$37,681.99 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ("FDEP"), TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR COMPLIANCE ACTIVITIES AT FACILITIES PERMITTED PURSUANT TO TITLE V OF THE CLEAN AIR ACT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 26-041; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES DEPARTMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2025-2026 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) **Explanation of Appropriation**

The appropriation above is a grant award from the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for the purpose of, among other things, providing funding

assistance for the Title V activities performed by the City of Jacksonville's approved local air pollution control program. The grant period commenced on October 1, 2025 and ends June 30, 2027. No local match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding assistance for the Title V activities performed by the City's approved local air pollution control program. The City will cooperate with FDEP for the monitoring of certain activities to evaluate and ensure compliance with the requirements of Title V of the Clean Air Act. A copy of the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Standard Grant Agreement, Agreement Number TV032, has been placed **On File** with the Legislative Services Division.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2026-2027.

Section 4. Oversight. The Office of Administrative Services Department, Environmental Quality Division, shall oversee the grant and project described herein, including preparation and submittal of any reports required by the grant.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
