Bill Summary: The bill expresses the City Council's support for Florida House Bill 21 designating bridge #724420 on Howell Drive over the Ribault River as the "Coach Gwendolyn Maxwell Bridge to Ribault" and authorizing erection of appropriate signage.

Background Information: City concurrence with the honorary designation of the bridge as passed by the Florida Legislature during its 2023 session is required before signage can be posted. Gwendolyn Maxwell taught in public schools in Jacksonville and Nassau County for 36 years and was head coach of the girls' track and field team at Ribault High School for 20 years from 1977 to 1997. During that time her teams won 4 state championships and finished as runners-up an additional 4 times. Ms. Maxwell, who died in 2020, coached U.S. Olympian Chandra Cheesborough was inducted into the Ribault Athletic Hall of Fame, the Bob Hayes Track Meet Hall of Fame, and the Florida Athletic Coaches Hall of Fame.
