AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$420,318.00 FROM THE SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (THE "FUND") INCLUDING \$400,318.00 TO PROCURE CAPITAL AND JACKSONVILLE OTHER EOUIPMENT FOR VARIOUS SHERIFF'S OFFICE DIVISIONS AND FACILITIES AS PARTICULARLY HEREIN, AND MORE OUTLINED \$20,000.00 TO PROVIDE CONTINUATION FUNDING TO THE HOMEWARD BOUND PROGRAM; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$420,318.00 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund including \$400,318.00 to procure capital and other equipment for various Jacksonvile Sheriff's Office divisions and facilities and providing \$20,000.00 in

continuation funding for the Homeward Bound Program.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to procure capital and other equipment for various Jacksonville Sheriff's Office divisions and facilities including: (1) \$34,322.00 for security camera upgrades for Jacksonville Sheriff's Office facilities; (2) \$63,858.00 for Patrol non-capital equipment; (3) \$102,641.00 for Patrol capital equipment; (4) \$122,673.00 for Investigations capital equipment; and (5) \$76,824.00 for Corrections capital equipment. In addition, this appropriation includes \$20,000.00 to provide continuation funding for the Homeward Bound Program.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
