AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, A ROADWAY JURISDICTION TRANSFER (RJT) AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") TRANSFERRING FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO THE CITY A PORTION OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY KNOWN AS UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD (ROADWAY ID 72110000) (THE "ROADWAY") INCLUDING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEOPERATION, MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR OF THE ROADWAY PROVIDING FOR RECORDING OF RIGHT-OF-WAY MAPS IN THE PUBLIC LAND RECORDS BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Approved. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City of Jacksonville, the Roadway Jurisdiction Transfer (RJT) Agreement between Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") and the City of Jacksonville ("City"), in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit

1 and incorporated herein by reference (the "Agreement"). FDOT owns a certain right-of-way located within the corporate limits of the City and known as University Boulevard (Roadway ID 72110000) commencing at milepost 0.218 and extending to milepost 1.688 (the "Roadway"), all as more particularly shown on the location map attached to the Agreement as Exhibit A. The Agreement transfers from the State Highway System to the City of Jacksonville the Roadway and the responsibility for the operation, maintenance, and repair of the Roadway, including the actual roadbed, together with the right-of-way and all bridges, curbs, culverts, drainage structures, sidewalks, bike paths, and other ways located within the Roadway. Upon completion of the transfer, the City shall own, operate, maintain, and repair the Roadway and all improvements therein. The Agreement also provides for transfer of the Roadway by right-of-way map transfer to be recorded in the public land records by the City.

Section 2. Oversight Department. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works shall have oversight with respect to the Agreement and project described herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
