4 **RESOLUTION 2026-206**

5 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT
6 OF CODY MASHNI, A DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT, AS AN
7 ALTERNATE MEMBER OF THE FIVE POINTS DEPENDENT
8 SPECIAL DISTRICT BOARD OF SUPERVISORS IN
9 ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHARTER OF THE FIVE POINTS
10 DEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT, ESTABLISHED BY
11 ORDINANCE 2025-539-E, FOR AN INITIAL TWO-YEAR
12 TERM TO EXPIRE JUNE 30, 2028; REQUESTING ONE
13 CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
14 DATE.

16 **WHEREAS**, Section 189.02, *Florida Statutes*, provides that the
17 City Council may create dependent special districts for the purpose
18 of delivering essential services to specific areas within the City;
19 and

20 **WHEREAS** on October 28, 2025, the City Council enacted Ordinance
21 2025-539-E creating the Five Points Dependent Special District (the
22 "District") and establishing the Charter of the District, which was
23 created to provide continuing services that include, but are not
24 limited to, the provision of elevated levels of security, landscaping
25 and promotion within the geographic boundaries of the District; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the District's Charter established the Board of
27 Supervisors as the District's governing body, comprised of five
28 Supervisors and three Alternates, each appointed to serve two-year
29 terms; and

30 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 6(b), of the District Charter,
31 three Supervisors and two Alternates shall be appointed by the Council

1 President and confirmed by the City Council, and two Supervisors and
2 one Alternate shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the
3 City Council; now therefore

4 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

5 **Section 1. Confirmation of Appointment.** The Council hereby
6 confirms the Mayor's appointment of Cody Mashni, a Duval County
7 resident, as an alternate member of the Five Points Dependent Special
8 District Board of Supervisors in accordance with the Charter of the
9 Five Points Dependent Special District, for an initial two-year term
10 to expire June 30, 2028.

11 **Section 2. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
12 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this
13 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is the desire
14 for the Board to be fully seated in order to commence their work in
15 a timely manner, including the development of an annual budget prior
16 to the April 1st deadline.

17 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
18 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
19 without the Mayor's signature.
