Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, 8 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 9 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 10 listed in subsection (b): (B.T. 25-063, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 11 12 by this reference) 13 (a) Appropriated from: See B.T. 25-063 \$485,000 14 15 (b) Appropriated to: See B.T. 25-063 \$485,000 16 17 Explanation of Appropriation: (C) The funding above represents an appropriation of \$400,000 18 in grant funds from the Florida Department of Children and 19 20 Families, Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health for 21 implementation of a Criminal Justice, Mental Health, and 22 Substance Abuse Reinvestment Grant Program ("CJMHSA Program") and an \$85,000 cash match from the Kids Hope 23 24 Alliance ("KHA") Fund for the first year of the grant. The 25 overall grant term is three (3) years, with the first year 26 beginning April 1, 2025 and ending March 31, 2026. 27 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 28 Section 1 is to provide funding for the first year of a CJMHSA Program 29 for the period beginning April 1, 2025 and ending March 31, 2026, and

CJMHSA Program is to improve care coordination services for juvenile 1 2 justice youth with indicators for mental health, substance use, and/or 3 trauma, and to expand the diversion continuum of community-based resources to reduce number of youth entering high levels of care. 4 5 This award is subject to the terms and conditions outlined in Contract No. LH881 (CSFA Number 60.115) between the State of Florida, 6 7 Department of Children and Families and the City of Jacksonville, 8 which has been placed **On File** with the Legislative Services Division 9 and incorporated herein by this reference.

10 Section 3. Amending Third Revised Schedule M to Ordinance 11 2024-511-E. The Kids Hope Alliance fiscal year 2024-2025 budget 12 approved by Ordinance 2024-511-E is hereby amended by substituting 13 in the place of the Third Revised Schedule M, the Fourth Revised 14 Schedule M, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by 15 this reference, to reflect the funds appropriated herein.

Section 4. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), 16 17 Ordinance Code. KHA is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. for the 18 19 implementation and administration of the CJMHSA Program in compliance 20 with the grant described in Section 2 above. Pursuant to Section Part 1 21 126.108(q)(Exemptions from competitive solicitation), 22 (General Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), 23 Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is 24 exempted from competitive solicitation because the services to be 25 provided are being approved via authorizing legislation pursuant to 26 this Ordinance. With the exception of the foregoing, all other 27 provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force 2.8 and effect.

29 Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. The 30 Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the 31 Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute and

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deliver a contract between KHA and Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. pursuant to which Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. will provide professional services necessary for local implementation and administration of the CJMHSA Program in compliance with the grant described in Section 2.

Waiving the Requirements of Section 77.111(a), 6 Section 6. 7 Ordinance Code. The City hereby waives the requirements of Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), 8 9 Ordinance Code, with respect to the contract with Managed Access to 10 Child Health, Inc. approved and authorized in Section 5 of this Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's 11 Ordinance. 12 services provided by third parties to be competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed in order to 13 allow KHA to directly contract with Managed Access to Child Health, 14 15 Inc. to provide the CJMHSA Program services described in the grant described in Section 2. 16

Section 7. Oversight Department. The Kids Hope Alliance
shall oversee administration of the grant and the CJMHSA Program.

19 Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 21 without the Mayor's signature.
