The City is proposing to utilize the Recapture Enhanced Value (REV) Grant program as stated in the City's Public Investment Policy (PIP). The company is investing a total of \$35 million and working to eliminate blight. Based on the capital investment in the Level 1 Economically Distressed Area, the City is proposing a REV Grant in the amount of 50 percent of the increase in real and personal property taxes generated at the project site, for 5 years, up to a maximum of \$1 million. Funding will be budgeted annually, as applicable, during the budget process.
