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ORDINANCE 2023-668-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ("SJC"), AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 163.01, STATUTES. FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLOCATING THE DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS WITH REGARD PERMITTING, OPERATION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF CERTAIN PORTIONS OF RACE TRACK ROAD PORTIONS THEREOF IN BOTH CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 11 AND SJC; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville ("City") and Eastland Development Group, Inc. ("Eastland") entered into an agreement with respect to the funding and construction of widening to four (4) lanes a portion of Race Tack Road ("East Section of Race Track Road"), which is located in the City and transitions into St. Johns County, Florida ("SJC"), which agreement was authorized by Ordinance 2021-787-E;

WHEREAS, upon completion of construction of the East Section of Race Track Road, those portions of the East Section of Race Track Road owned by Eastland located within the City and SJC will be dedicated and conveyed to the City and SJC as to those portions located within each jurisdiction respectively; and

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agreement to allocate the duties and obligations between the parties with regard to the permitting, operation, maintenance and repair of the East Section of Race Track Road and provide that after conveyance, SJC shall operate, maintain and repair the East Section of Race Track Road in a good and workmanlike manner at its sole cost and expense; now therefore,

WHEREAS, City and SJC desire to enter into an interlocal

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Incorporating Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance upon adoption thereof.

Approval and Execution of Interlocal Agreement Section 2. authorized. There is hereby approved, and Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Interlocal Agreement between City and SJC, in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"), as authorized by Section 163.01, Florida Statutes. The Agreement may include such additions, deletions, and changes as may be reasonable, necessary, and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor or her designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor or her designee; provided however, no modification of the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement, and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel. For purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City or other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase

the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of 1 2 the Agreement. 3 Section 3. Oversight. The Public Works Department shall provide oversight of the Agreement and the project described 4 herein. 5 Effective Date.
