## ORDINANCE 2021-318

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$225,000 FROM THE JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY INVESTMENT SOCIAL SPECIAL COMMITTEE CONTINGENCY FOR THE QUENCH THE VIOLENCE REWORK PROGRAM; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE QUENCH THE VIOLENCE, INC.; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH QUENCH THE VIOLENCE, INC. TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES FOR THE QUENCH THE VIOLENCE REWORK PROGRAM; WAIVING SECTION 110.112 (ADVANCE OF CITY FUNDS; PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A PARTIAL ADVANCE PAYMENT BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation - The funding above is being appropriated from the Social Justice and Community Investment Special Committee Contingency to be utilized by Quench the Violence, Inc. for the Quench the Violence ReWork program.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the Quench the Violence ReWork program as more fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto. The Quench the Violence ReWork program will equip unemployed, underemployed and justice involved young adults in Jacksonville who have aged out of public education (18 to 25) with the personal, psycho-social and self-awareness skills, training and credentials to excel in obtaining a sustainable career pathway as productive citizens in our community. It will provide wrap-around services for involved and unemployed/underemployed residents justice of Jacksonville, ages 18 to 25.

Section 3. Agreement approved and execution authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Quench the Violence, Inc., in substantially the form as attached hereto as Exhibit 3, and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his

designee; provided however, no modification to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of Quench the Violence, Inc., and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of Quench the Violence, Inc., to provide services for the Quench the Violence ReWork program. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Code. Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived to allow for a partial advance payment as described in the Agreements.

Section 6. Oversight. The Mayor is requested to appoint the Office of Grants and Contract Compliance to oversee the project in Section 2 above and to ensure compliance with all other appropriate laws.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature. Form Approved: /s/ Margaret M.
