Council Member Peluso explained the bill.

Council Member Carlucci expressed his support.

Council Member Boylan talked about his addition to the NCSPHS amendment to strike "or attempting to promote" within the enhanced penalty language and add "so as to endanger a person or persons" within the enhanced penalty language. The NCSPHS amendment was approved by the committee.

Council Member Miller asked about the Sheriff's opinion on this bill.

Council Member Boylan spoke in opposition to the counter-arguments about JSO enforcement, duplicating state law and free speech infringement.

Council Member Johnson shared the tragic story about Jonnie Mae Chappell.

Council Member Freeman said legislation doesn't affect what is in peoples' hearts.

Council Member Johnson asked if there are duplicative local, state and federal laws. Jason Teal, OGC, answered in the affirmative. Council Member Johnson said he senses micro-aggressions of violence in this debate and he is disappointed that we haven't gotten beyond that in our community. Council Member Peluso said he's open to having more meetings to discuss further improvements to the bill if necessary, but these hateful acts are still happening in our community as lately as today, so a mere resolution isn't going to deal with the problem. He said what's proposed isn't duplicative but provides a local enhancement to what is available as a deterrent.

Council Member Freeman said resolutions do carry weight and to say otherwise devalues the work of the Council. He said resolutions do spark strong feelings in people, as the Council has learned this year. He expressed disappointment that the philosophical disagreement on this issue is deeply dividing the Council.

Council Member Howland agreed with Council Member Freeman that enhanced penalties are not the solution to the problem, and said there are already many laws on the books that cover what this bill covers. He is working on legislation to erect a historical marker at the site of the killing of Johnnie Mae Chappell to educate the community about what happened there so it is not forgotten.
