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ORDINANCE 2024-756

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM A GENERAL FUND OPERATING - SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING - MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS AND AIDS ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL CITY GRANT FUNDS TO WELLS CREEK EAST HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC, FOR OFF-DUTY TRAFFIC CONTROL SERVICES AT THE INTERSECTION OF WELLS CREEK PARKWAY AND PHILIPS HIGHWAY SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER; PROVIDING FOR REVERTER OF FUNDS; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT FOR OFF-DUTY TRAFFIC CONTROL SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND WELLS CREEK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC (THE "AGREEMENT"), TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM INDEBTEDNESS OF THE AGREEMENT BY AN ADDITIONAL NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$10,000, TO ATTACH A REVISED SCOPE OF WORK, AND TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT TO DECEMBER 31, 2024; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUED OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$10,000 from a General Fund Operating - Subsidies and Contributions to Private Organizations account to the General Fund Operating - Miscellaneous Grants and Aids account, to provide additional City grant funds to Wells Creek East Homeowners Association, Inc ("Wells Creek East") for off-duty traffic control services at the intersection of Wells Creek Parkway and Philips Highway subject to the terms and conditions outlined herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide additional City grant funding to Wells Creek East Homeowners Association, Inc for procurement of off-duty traffic control services for the intersection of Wells Creek Parkway and Philips Highway. These funds are in addition to funds previously appropriated for off-duty traffic control services at this intersection by Ordinance 2023-881-E and this appropriation shall be subject to the same terms and conditions outlined and approved by Ordinance 2023-881-E except as amended herein.

This request arises from a delay in receipt and installation of

the traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Wells Creek Parkway and Philips Highway and the need for these services to continue while school is in session. In the event these additional City funds are exhausted prior to completion of the traffic signal, Wells Creek East and Wells Creek Property Owners Association, Inc. have expressed their intent to equally bear the costs for continued off-duty traffic control services as described herein until completion of the intersection.

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Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to December 31, 2024.

Section 4. Reverter. Any funds remaining after completion of the project described herein shall be returned to the account of origin.

Approval and Authorization to Execute First Section 5. Amendment to Agreement. The Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a first amendment to the Contract For Off-Duty Traffic Control Services between the City of Jacksonville and Wells Creek East Homeowners Association, Inc (the "Agreement") originally approved by Ordinance 2023-881-E, to increase the maximum indebtedness under the Agreement by an additional \$10,000 for a new total maximum indebtedness notto-exceed \$35,000, to revise the Scope of Work outlined in the Agreement as provided in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, and to extend the term of the Agreement to December 31, 2024, with all other terms of the Agreement remaining the same except as expressly provided herein. The first amendment may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or her designee, wish such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the first amendment by the Mayor, or her designee; provided however, no modifications to

the first amendment may increase the financial obligations of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated herein nor decrease the duties and obligations of Wells Creek East, and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification terms. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City, and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall continue to have oversight of the project described herein.

Section 7. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the school year has commenced and there will be a delay in installation of the anticipated traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Wells Creek Parkway and Philips Highway. Recognizing that traffic is at its heaviest in this area when school is in session, which is also when traffic accidents are most likely to occur, the City Council wants to ensure there is not a lapse in the provision of off-duty traffic control services at this intersection.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
