5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION 6 7 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON 8 BEHALF OF THE CITY, A ROADWAY JURISDICTION 9 TRANSFER (RJT) AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT 10 11 OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") TRANSFERRING FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO THE CITY A PORTION OF 12 13 THE RIGHT-OF-WAY KNOWN AS UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD (ROADWAY ID 72110000) (THE "ROADWAY") INCLUDING 14 15 THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE OPERATION, MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR OF THE ROADWAY 16 AND 17 PROVIDING FOR RECORDING OF RIGHT-OF-WAY MAPS IN THE PUBLIC LAND RECORDS BY THE CITY; PROVIDING 18 FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND 19 20 CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE 21 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN 22 EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 Section 1. Roadway Jurisdiction Transfer Agreement 26 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her Approved. designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to 27 28 execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City of Jacksonville, 29 the Roadway Jurisdiction Transfer (RJT) Agreement between Florida 30 Department of Transportation ("FDOT") and the City of Jacksonville 31 ("City"), in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit

1 1 and incorporated herein by reference (the "Agreement"). FDOT owns 2 a certain right-of-way located within the corporate limits of the 3 City and known as University Boulevard (Roadway ID 72110000) commencing at milepost 0.218 and extending to milepost 1.688 (the 4 5 "Roadway"), all as more particularly shown on the location map attached to the Agreement as Exhibit A. The Agreement transfers from 6 7 the State Highway System to the City of Jacksonville the Roadway and the responsibility for the operation, maintenance, and repair of the 8 9 Roadway, including the actual roadbed, together with the right-of-10 way and all bridges, curbs, culverts, drainage structures, sidewalks, 11 bike paths, and other ways located within the Roadway. Upon completion of the transfer, the City shall own, operate, maintain, and repair 12 the Roadway and all improvements therein. The Agreement also provides 13 14 for transfer of the Roadway by right-of-way map transfer to be recorded in the public land records by the City. 15

16 Section 2. Oversight Department. The Engineering and 17 Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works 18 shall have oversight with respect to the Agreement and project 19 described herein.

20 Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 22 without the Mayor's signature.
