The company is also considering locating the proposed facility in a few other port cities along the eastern U.S. seaboard. If Jacksonville is selected, they propose to create an additional 60 new full-time jobs no later than December 31, 2027. The average annual wage is \$50,500 plus benefits. Arcadia Cold Jacksonville, LLC has stated that the City of Jacksonville's financial incentive proposed is a material factor in its decision to locate its warehouse and distribution center, in Jacksonville.
