3 **Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2. Section 1 is to re-allocate HOME Grant Program funds originally 4 appropriated by Ordinance 2020-258-E to provide funding 5 for downpayment assistance and rehabilitation of affordable housing for 6 7 rent or ownership by low- and moderate-income individuals and families and to correct certain revenue and project information provided on 8 9 BT21-003 as approved by Ordinance 2020-258-E. This re-allocation is 10 necessary to adjust for the Governor's veto of affordable housing funding in the State of Florida fiscal year 2020-2021 budget and will 11 allow these programs to remain open for a portion of the 2020-2021 12 fiscal year instead of remaining closed. In addition, HUD has 13 approved, via an administrative waiver, the City's use of up to 14 twenty-five percent (25%) of these funds to pay for the City's 15 16 administration of the HOME Grant Program.
