NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, of a public hearing by Authority (the "Authority") to be held on July 16, 2021, at 10:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, for the purpose of receiving comments and hearing discussion concerning the issuance by the Authority of its Homeowner Mortgage Revenue Bonds in one or more series, in an aggregate face amount of not to exceed \$100,000,000 (the "Bonds").
