5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$418,750.00 FROM THE
6 STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
7 PROTECTION ("FDEP") FOR THE DUVAL COUNTY 2022
8 HURRICANE IAN AND NICOLE RECOVERY PROJECT, AS
9 INITIATED BY B.T. 23-095; PROVIDING FOR
10 OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS,
11 ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT
12 DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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14 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
16 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
17 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
18 listed in subsection (b):

25 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

26 The funding above represents an appropriation of
27 \$418,750.00 from the State of Florida Department of
28 Environmental Protection ("FDEP") for the Duval County 2022
29 Hurricane Ian and Nicole Recovery Project (the "Project").
30 The Project is cooperatively funded through federal and
31 state dollars. This appropriation reflects FDEP's cost

1 share obligation for the Project.

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
3 Section 1 is to receive and allocate FDEP's portion of funding for
4 the Project which consists of beach and dune restoration from the
5 north end of Hanna Park to the south end of Duval County. This
6 Project is necessary to mitigate beach and dune erosion sustained
7 during Hurricanes Ian and Nicole. The funds will be used for work
8 performed, including placement of fill material and/or construction
9 of erosion control structures. FDEP has determined that the non-
10 federal costs for the Project are eligible for 100 percent
11 reimbursement up to \$418,750.00 and thus a local match from the City
12 will not be required.

13 A copy of the State of Florida Department of Environmental
14 Protection Standard Grant Agreement (Agreement Number: 23DU2) (the
15 "Agreement") providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt
16 and expenditure of FDEP funds for the Project has been placed **On File**
17 with the Office of Legislative Services. The term of the Agreement
18 commenced on September 28, 2022, and continues through December 31,
19 2025.

20 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Department of Public Works,
21 Engineering and Construction Management Division, shall oversee
22 administration of the Agreement described herein.

23 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
25 without the Mayor's signature.
