PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain Why this legislation is necessary? Provide; Who, What, When, Where, How and the Impact.) Council Research will complete this form for Council introduced legislation and the Administration is responsible for all other legislation.

Ordinance 2025-328-E authorized the lease and buildout of a Duval County Tax Collector office at 11160 Beach Blvd. The ordinance appropriated \$2,429,472 from Tax Collector interest earnings to fund the project, including the buildout, relocation expenses, office furniture/equipment and the first six months of rent. Under the lease agreement, the landlord serves as the contractor for the buildout, with a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,415,241 established for the landlord's portion of the construction costs. However, the legislation did not include a contingency to the landlord's portion of the buildout in the event that change orders become necessary. Following permitting and plan review, a change order in the amount of \$44,897.19 is required to complete the buildout. The proposed change order is attached. No additional appropriation or transfer of funds is required, as sufficient funding has already been appropriated within the total project budget. Accordingly, we are requesting authorization to amend the contract to allow for this change order, as well as authorization to approve any additional change orders provided that such change orders do not exceed the total amount appropriated for the project and do not exceed 10 percent of the contractor's originally authorized buildout costs.

The funds for this project are derived from previously appropriated Duval County Tax Collector interest earnings, as authorized by Ordinance 2025-328-E. The requested change order relates solely to the construction costs necessary to complete the approved buildout. Funds are paid to the landlord (TCI Construction) pursuant to the lease agreement. The requested change order will be incorporated into the existing contract and funded within the total amount already appropriated for the project. No matching funds are required. The project is fully funded through previously approved appropriation.
