AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$68,000.00 GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF RADIO EQUIPMENT TO UPGRADE THE EXISTING RADIO USED BY THE MUTUAL AID EQUIPMENT RADIO COMMUNICATIONS ("MARC") PROGRAM, WHICH IS CURRENTLY OUT OF MANUFACTURER SUPPORT, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS IN RESPONSE TO ALL HAZARDS EMERGENCIES, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-113; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT AND REPORTING BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$68,000.00 in grant funding from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security through the Florida Division of Emergency Management for the purchase of radio equipment to maintain the operational capabilities of the MARC unit by replacing equipment that has become outdated as described below. The grant period commences upon execution of the grant agreement by both parties and ends on March 31, 2024. No City match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the purchase of radio equipment to replace the radio cache used by the MARC program. This update will ensure continued interoperability of disparate communications systems and technologies during response to all hazards emergencies by updating the existing cache of portable radios that are out of manufacturer support. A copy of the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement (Agreement Number: R0756) providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds has been placed On File with the Legislative Services Division.

Section 3. Oversight and Reporting. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee administration of the grant described herein and shall be responsible for submittal of the required quarterly reports in accordance with the grant agreement.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
