5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$134,615.00 IN GRANT
6 FUNDING FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
7 JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF
8 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF
9 LOCATIVE TRACKING DEVICES AND RELATED SUPPLIES,
10 AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-034; PROVIDING FOR
11 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE'S SHERIFF'S
12 OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
16 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
17 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
18 listed in subsection (b):

26 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
27 funds in the amount of \$134,615.00 from the United States
28 Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau
29 of Justice Assistance, through its BJA FY 23 The Kevin and
30 Avonte Program: Reducing Injury and Death of Missing
31 Individuals with Dementia and Developmental Disabilities

1 to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to fund the purchase
2 of the locative tracking devices and related supplies for
3 the purpose of expanding an existing tracking program by
4 increasing the number of tracking devices from 20 to 220
5 devices. No local match is required. The grant period is
6 from October 1, 2023 and continues through September 30,
7 2026.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
9 Section 1 is to fund the purchase of locative tracking devices to
10 expand an existing locative tracking program from 20 to 220 devices.
11 This will allow the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to more aptly serve
12 the City's population. This project will provide locative tracking
13 devices at no cost to voluntary participants and serve individuals
14 of any age who have forms of dementia or a developmental disability
15 and are prone to wander from safe environments.

16 A copy of the Grant Award Letter (Award Number 15PBJA-23-GG-
17 04243-MAPX) outlining the terms and conditions and uses of the grant
18 funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
19 reference.

20 **Section 3. Oversight Department.** The Jacksonville
21 Sheriff's Office shall oversee administration of the grant described
22 herein.

23 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
25 without the Mayor's signature.
