22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
25 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to

(c) Explanation of appropriation:

The funding above is a reimbursement grant from the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection for a project titled AAA Public Engagement Workshops for Continued Resiliency Planning.

Section 2. Carryover. The funds appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into the subsequent fiscal year.

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for AAA Public Engagement Workshops for Continued Resiliency Planning. Funds will be used to engage the public through several workshops at which sea level rise and flooding scenarios will be presented along with proposed policies or recommendations to address these issues.

Section 4. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are authorized to execute and deliver, the Standard Grant Agreement between the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the City of Jacksonville, a copy of which has been placed **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 5. Oversight. The Planning and Development Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
