The two vehicles to be supplused are a Horton Rescue Unit (VIN #1GB3CZG1FF180231) and a Pierce Dash Pumper (VIN #4P1CD01W54A004380). Ft Myers was devastated by Hurrican Ian and these aparatus are critical for protection and support of the community. This legislation authroizes the disposition of the two vehicles to the Fort Mysers Beach Fire Control District in an effort to assist the citizens of Ft Myers through their revocery efforts.
