The statute defines the CHHA as the area below the elevation of the category 1 storm surge line as established by a Sea, Lake, and Overland Surges from Hurricanes (SLOSH) computerized storm surge model. The SLOSH model for northeast Florida is periodically updated by the Northeast Florida Regional Council and this amendment updates the map consistent with the most recent data.
