

**Revised Contract with FSCJ for Operation Boost:**

- Adds requirement that students receiving scholarships and emergency assistance be residents of Duval County
- Revises timing of \$100,000 funding so that funds are paid in advance in 4 equal quarterly installments rather than payment being made as expense reimbursement
- Adds requirement that scholarships be used for to cover costs associated with attending FSCJ, including, but not limited to, tuition, fees, housing, books, transportation and personal costs
- Adds requirement that emergency expenses be used to cover unexpected costs that arise while students are attending FSCJ and may be a barrier for an eligible student to complete a course of study
- Requires any funds not used for scholarships or emergency assistance at end of term to be repaid to the City
- Makes clean up changes deleting provisions inconsistent with the nature of services provided under this contract, correcting Section references, and making certain changes requested by FSCJ due to their status as a state educational institution

**Revised Contract with Workforce Industrial Training, LLC ("WIT") for Operation Boost:**

- Adds requirement that students receiving services be residents of Duval County
- Revises payment of funds so that \$2,000 per student is paid upon completion of all required courses rather than payments being made on registration
- Clarifies that any advance payment (up to 25% of the contract amount) made to WIT must be fully recouped from \$2,000 per student payments otherwise payable to WIT before any per student payments are made
- Makes clean up changes correcting Section references
