#### **AUDITOR COMMENTS/CONCERNS:**

- Requiring approval of a Constitutional Officer adds another layer to what is currently a business decision made by experts in the field of risk management that is designed to promote fiscal responsibility and protect the City
- Unfavorable financial outcomes resulting from the decision to go to trial versus settle will ultimately be borne by the City, not the applicable Constitutional Officer
- The City maintains excess insurance coverage for claims in excess of the self-insured retention amount. Per Risk Management, there may be negative impacts to the City's excess insurance coverage (such as denial of coverage or increased rates) if Constitutional Officers are required to approve settlements.
- As proposed, the legislation does not provide the same settlement approval rights to 1) individual Council Members, who are also Constitutional Officers
- 2) City employees not reporting to a Constitutional Officer
