- Appoints the initial seven-member Board of Supervisors for the BCID and establishes qualifications of Board members and procedures for elections
- Establishes the duties of the BCID, including maintenance of roadways, common properties, and storm water infrastructure located within the BCID boundary
- Authorizes annual non-ad valorem special assessments for residential and commercial properties located in the BCID to be collected in any manner permitted by law
