- Continue funding to state agencies that offer grant opportunities for the implementation of projects and programs that impact the quality of life.



Community Resiliency

- Replacement/upgrade of water, wastewater, septic; stormwater; transportation; and utilities systems.
- Improve flood mitigation assistance for local governments.



Affordable Housing

- Ensure that the Sadowski Trust Fund is fully funded.
- Maintain key local government programs that provide for affordable housing opportunities.



Broadband

- Support affordable and reliable internet for all Floridians.
- Increased funding, grant opportunities, technical assistance, and the ability for governments to maintain local control.

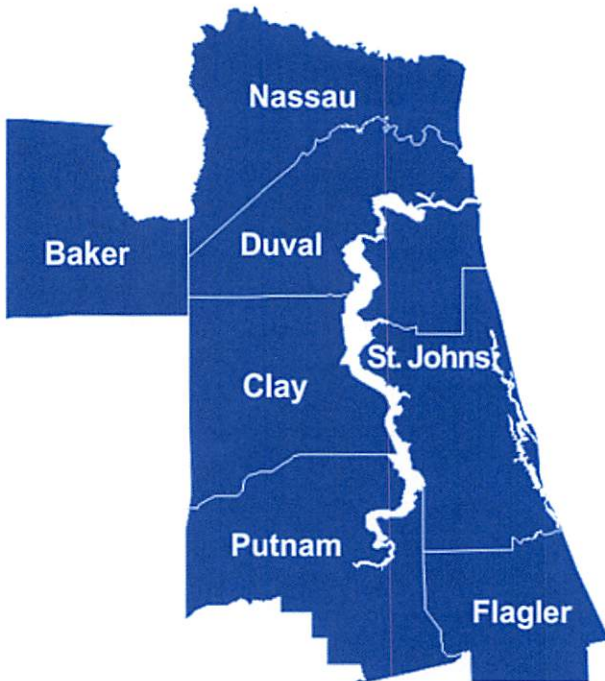
