whereas, the City of Jacksonville ("City") recognizes the strong presence of active military service members and veterans living in Jacksonville and the surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, through Ordinance 2021-212-E, the City created a pilot program to reduce the park admission fees for active service members and veterans by ½ for admission to Kathryn Abbey Hanna Park and Huguenot Memorial Park; and

WHEREAS, finding that the pilot program was successful, the Council now finds that the fee reduction program should be made permanent through creation of a new section in the Ordinance Code, Section 123.108; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Creating a new Section 123.108 (Military and Veterans' Appreciation Program; Reduction of certain park fees for military and veterans), Chapter 123 (Public Fees), Ordinance Code.

Section 123.108 (Military and Veterans' Appreciation Program; Reduction of certain park fees for military and veterans), Part 1 (In General), Chapter 123 (Public Fees), Ordinance Code, is hereby created to add a new section as follows:

CHAPTER 123. PUBLIC FEES.

PART 1. IN GENERAL.

* * *

Sec. 123.108. Military and Veterans' Appreciation Program; Reduction of certain park fees for military and veterans.

There is herby approved and adopted within the City a "Military and Veterans' Appreciation Program." The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department is authorized to reduce current daily admission fees by % for fees charged at Kathryn Abbey Hanna Park and Huguenot Memorial Park (which may be applied to car, pedestrian and biker admission but not on annual passes) for all active military service members, and their immediate family members (spouse and minor children), and veterans, regardless of residency in Jacksonville. In order to qualify for the reduced admission fees, the active military service member (or their family member), or veteran must produce at the park entrance at the time of admission a state issued military ID, DD214 ID, or veteran ID.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
