		1. Correct scrivener's errors.
		2. Pg. 14, line 18: strike "standard form" and insert "uniform method".
		3. Pg. 15, line 30: correct Florida Statute reference to 189.02(4)(d).4. Pg. 18, line 11: strike "upon" and insert "or their designee until".
		5. Pg. 19, lines 25-30: revise language to mirror voter language in Ordinance Code.
		6. Correct section numbering within bill.
		7. Attach Revised Exhibit 2 to correct scrivener's errors.
		8. Include provision for opt-out from BCID membership if a property does not use
		Baymeadows Circle East or Baymeadows Circle West and the property does not utilize
		the stormwater or drainage system of the BCID, and define the process for satisfying
		the conditions.

Include amendment of 2021-504-E, the FY 2022 budget ordinance, to replace the Second Revised B4 and Second Revised B4b schedules to reflect the additional borrowing and attach new Exhibits 3 and 4. 4. Attach Revised Exhibit 2 (CIP) to correct footing error.
21-887	Amendment	 (ORD Transfer \$18,833.39 from the Art in Public Places Proj Fund to the Winton Dr Park Art in Public Places Proj.): 1. Strike references to "transferring" and insert "appropriating". 2. Attach Revised Exhibit 2 (CIP Sheet) to correct the prior years' appropriations.
21-890	Amendment	 (ORD Approp a City Match of the Total Remaining Funds (Currently \$267,798.00) from the AES Cedar Bay Settlement Stipulation Acct Fund to Contribute Toward the Acquisition Cost of Approx (345± Acres) on Black Hammock Island): 1. Revise appropriation amount to \$267,797.93. 2. Clarify appropriation language in bill. 3. Attach Revised Exhibit 1 to correct appropriation amount to \$267,797.93 on BT. 4. Attach Revised Exhibit 3 to correct appropriation amount in grant contract.
21-891	Amendment	 (ORD-MC re FL Inland Navigation Dist (FIND) Grants; Amend Sec 117.110 (Florida Inland Navigation District (Find) (Grants), Chapt 117 (Grants), Ord Code, to Require that the Mayor Notify Council of Excess Funds in the FIND Match Acct after FIND Apvl of Annual Projs & to Require that the Council President File Legislation to Transfer the Excess Match Funding to a Special Council Contingency Acct for Waterways Improvements): 1. Adds language that details any excess FIND grant match funding shall remain in the FIND grant contingency.
