- 1. Increase the percentage of affordable units required in new developments to at least 20%.
- 2. Provide greater support for the development of community land trusts.
- 3. Include provisions for the protection of tenants' rights, such as prohibiting no-cause evictions, requiring landlords to provide a valid reason for eviction, and limiting rent increases to a reasonable percentage each year.
- 4. Establish an independent oversight committee to monitor the implementation and effectiveness of the bill's accountability and transparency measures.
- 5. Increase public access to information by requiring government agencies to proactively disclose information to the public through online portals and provide regular reports on their activities.
- 6. Strengthen whistleblower protections by establishing an independent office to receive and investigate whistleblower complaints and providing legal protections for whistleblowers who come forward.
- 7. Implement mandatory ethics training for all government employees to ensure that they are aware of their responsibilities and obligations to the public.
- 8. Establish clear and specific consequences for government officials who engage in misconduct or violate ethical standards, proportional to the severity of the offense and enforced consistently.
