

CARLUCCI AMENDMENT

Council Member Carlucci offers the following amendment to File No. 2024-373:

- (1) On **page 4, line 1½, insert** new language to read as follows:
"(c) Any new zoning overlay shall require the approval of two-thirds of Council Members present. Any waiver by Ordinance of this Section shall require the approval of two-thirds of Council Members present. For purposes of this Section, the number of Council Members present shall mean all Council Members present and counted for purposes of determining a quorum, regardless of any voting abstentions.";
- (2) On **page 5, lines 13-14, strike** "Waivers of this prohibition shall require approval by a 2/3 vote of the full Council." and **insert** "Waivers of this prohibition require the approval of two-thirds of the Council Members present. Any waiver by Ordinance of this Section shall require the approval of two-thirds of the Council Members present. For purposes of this Section, the number of Council Members present shall mean all Council Members present and counted for purposes of determining a quorum, regardless of any voting abstentions.";
- (3) On **page 1, line 1,** amend the introductory sentence to add that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
