Include new whereas clause(s) explaining additional notices sent to property owners who were missed in the initial noticing process and attach notices and responses as new exhibit. 2. Attach revised Exhibits 1, 2, 3, and 4 to remove property owner who was incorrectly noticed. 3. Reflect that Dr. Groover has passed away. 4. Correct scrivener's errors.
