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23-7	Amendment	 (ORD-Q Rezoning at 1004 Hendricks Ave, 0 & 1454 Prudential Drive, & 0 Home St, btwn Prudential Dr & Hendricks Ave - (1.01± Acres) from CCBD to PUD; to Permit Commercial Uses, as Described in the Downtown Southbank Mixed-Use PUD): 1. Update the Comprehensive Plan references to the 2045 Comprehensive Plan. 2. Rezoning approved subject to 4 conditions: a) The ground level retail space shall not be less than 16,000 square feet. b) Except for the self-storage office, no personal property self-storage uses shall be located at the ground level. c) The ground level self-storage office space shall have frontage on Home Street and not on Prudential Drive or Hendricks Avenue. d) Nothing in the Site Plan, Written Description or any other provision of this Ordinance supersedes the requirements for closing of a street, alley, or public right-of-way in Chapter 744, Ordinance Code, or other applicable requirements in the City of Jacksonville Ordinance Code or Florida Statutes. Failure to close any street, alley or public right-of-way within the project area does not relieve the developer of any design or other requirement imposed by the Downtown Development Review Board and does not relieve the developer of any potential requirement for additional review by the Downtown Development Review Board if the project is redesigned due to the failure to close any street, alley, or public right-of-way within the project area.
