Section 804.1012 18 (Unauthorized parking in disabled parking space prohibited), Part 10 (Parking), Chapter 804 (Jacksonville Traffic Code), Ordinance Code, 19 20 is hereby amended to read as follows: 21 CHAPTER 804. - JACKSONVILLE TRAFFIC CODE 22 \* \* \* PART 10. - PARKING 23 \* \* \* 24 25 Sec. 804.1012. - Unauthorized parking or obstructing disabled 26 parking space, curb cut, or access aisle prohibited. It shall be unlawful for a person to park, stop or stand a 27 (a) vehicle in a parking space designated in accordance with the 28 provisions of F.S. § 316.1955 or F.S. § 316.1956 for use only 29 30 by the disabled unless the vehicle displays a parking permit issued pursuant to F.S. § 316.1958 or F.S. § 320.0848 and the 31

vehicle is transporting a person eligible for the parking 1 permit. It is unlawful for any person to park in or obstruct 2 3 the path of travel to an accessible parking space, curb cut, or access aisle by standing or parking a vehicle within any 4 5 such designated area or adjacent to such designated area in such a manner so as to unreasonably interfere with access to 6 7 or use of the area. The violator is subject to the same 8 penalties as are imposed for illegally parking in a space 9 that is designated as an accessible parking space for persons with disabilities. A person who is chauffeuring a disabled 10 person shall be allowed, without need for an identification 11 parking permit, momentary parking in the parking space for 12 the purpose of loading or unloading a disabled person and no 13 penalty shall be imposed upon the driver for this momentary 14 15 parking. A person convicted of violating this Section shall be punishable by a fine of \$250. A sign with a blue background 16 and white lettering reading "\$250 FINE" shall be attached to 17 each permanent abovegrade sign indicating such restricted 18 parking space; provided, however, that any failure to have 19 20 any such space so signed, whether due to full or partial 21 absence of a sign, improper colors, inaccurate amount of the 22 fine, defacement or mutilation, or otherwise, shall not impede, restrict or otherwise prevent 23 in any manner 24 whatsoever the enforceability of any restriction, violation 25 or fine set forth above or any other provisions relating to regulation of parking for disabled persons. 26

(d) All fines collected for violation of subsections (a) and (b)of this Section shall be distributed as follows:

(1) Seventy percent shall be placed in a separate account of the City at least once a month to be expended only to improve accessibility and equal opportunity to qualified physically disabled persons in the County and to provide funds to conduct public awareness programs in the County concerning physically disabled persons. These funds shall be appropriated by the Council prior to expenditure, but shall not lapse at the end of any fiscal year and shall remain available for expenditure for the purposes stated herein.

(2) The remaining percentage of the fines collected shall be distributed as provided by law.

12 Section 2. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the 13 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and 14 division "tables of contents" consistent with the changes set forth 15 herein. Such editorial changes and any others necessary to make the 16 Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are 17 approved and directed herein, and the changes to the Ordinance Code 18 shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

19 Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 21 without the Mayor's signature.
