8 *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF BOARD
9 MEMBERS NECESSARY FOR A QUORUM; PROVIDING FOR
10 CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN
11 EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1. Amending Section 78.104 (Organization;**
15 **administrative support), Chapter 78 (Safety and Crime Reduction**
16 **Commission), Ordinance Code.** Section 78.104 (Organization;
17 administrative support), Chapter 78 (Safety and Crime Reduction
18 Commission), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby amended to read as follows:

19 **CHAPTER 78. - SAFETY AND CRIME REDUCTION COMMISSION**

21 **Sec. 78.104. - Organization; administrative support.**

23 (c) *Voting; quorum.* All decisions and recommendations of the
24 Commission shall require a concurring vote of a majority of
25 the voting members present. ~~Eleven voting members shall~~
26 ~~constitute a quorum.~~ Tie votes shall result in the subject
27 agenda item being continued to the next meeting of the
28 Commission. A majority of the current membership of the
29 Commission, excluding vacant seats, shall constitute a quorum
30 for the purpose of meetings and transacting business. A
31 vacancy shall not impair the ability of a majority of the

1 remaining members to execute all the duties and perform all
2 the functions of the Commission.

4 **Section 2. Codification Instructions.** The Codifier and the
5 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and
6 division "tables of contents" consistent with the changes set forth
7 herein. Such editorial changes and any others necessary to make the
8 *Ordinance Code* consistent with the intent of this legislation are
9 approved and directed herein, and the changes to the *Ordinance Code*
10 shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

11 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
13 without the Mayor's signature.
